Financial Information Sheet

\$ Registration Fee: \$100 This fee is for new students and is non-refundable. It secures a spot in enrollment for your child and we begin the process of getting their records together and ordering books for your child. This also covers any entrance test that will be required of your child. Students currently enrolled in the Academy are allowed to enroll at a discounted rate in the month of April. A child is not officially enrolled until the registration fee is paid in full. This fee is non-refundable.

\$ SMART tuition Fee: \$45 per family. Smart tuition is a company that will be managing payments for PBA. (See attached information) Please note, **All families are required to enroll in the program.**

\$ Book/Administration Fee \$300 per student This Fee is due in full on or before July 15th. You may split payments in two - 1st on July 15th the 2nd on or before the first day of the 2nd semester. Each student will be charged a book rental/Administration fee each year. This fee is to help us purchase books and teaching aids that your child uses at PBA. It is due before your child attends school the first day. A student is charged an additional \$5 for each page that needs to be repeated.

\$ Sports Fee: \$100 per sport. Sports fees must be **paid before the first practice.** All sports fees are non refundable and non transferable (except within immediate family).

\$ Convention Fee: \$175 per student (7th-12th Grade) This fee is required for each students in 7th – 12th grade for our annual PILOTS convention. Due March 1st.

\$ POP Fee \$500 one child \$750 two or more children. We have established a Parents of Parkview or POP fee that is due in two parts per family each year. The first part is due on December 1st and the last ½ is due on May 1st. This is as much an obligation as tuition and book fees. This fee supplements tuition and is what we try to set aside for improvements to the building or the program of PBA. Each family can simply pay this or work it off through the various school wide fund-raisers the school will have. We ask parents to heartily participate in our fund raising programs so that we are able to reach our goal in that particular program. Please remember, fund-raisers are used to provide things that cannot be normally purchased through the tuition. Your participation in fund-raisers helps us to keep the cost of tuition down.

\$ Tuition Kindergarten – 12th Grades: See chart below. All tuition payments are due on the 15th of each month and will be considered late after the 15th and will be charged a \$35 late fee. If tuition is not paid by the end of the month we will begin the dismissal process of your child from school. Your timely and consistent payments or your tuition is expected and counted on.

Discounts: A 10% discount will be given to all tithing members Parkview Baptist Church Members.

Refund Policy: All fees are non-refundable. Tuition is charged in advance for the month your child attends. Tuition is due for the month in full if your child attends any part of the month.

There is a \$25 charge added to accounts in the event of a NON-Sufficient Funds (NSF) check.
